Artist Notes: I asked God to please show me what I must paint and I got this vision:

Paul was in prison when he prayed for the church. How many times when it is not going well with us do we pray for people that are doing very well? I saw Paul praying for them that they will realize the power they have in Jesus and that they would know that, we the people/children of God, are God's greatest treasure. I saw God's light shining down and how the Holy Spirit was poured out over them. The gold in the painting resembles two things. One is to show that God's children are his greatest treasure and two, God's presence through the Holy Spirit with his children. The hand resembles Paul praying and that he knows Jesus intimately. He knows the power there is in the name of Jesus and he wants the church to know that too, and to have a deep and intimate relationship with the Holy Trinity (God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit).

I feel truly blessed to have been able to paint this, but I do feel it was the Holy Spirit that painted it through me and I cannot take credit for this. I hope you can see and feel what I saw in this.
